

and I will call upon the Lord’s name. **(R)**







1. Blessed are the undefiled, who walk in the law of the Lord.  
Blessed are they who search his testimonies:  
that seek him with their whole heart. **(R)**
2. For they that work iniquity, have not walked in his ways.  
Thou hast commanded thy commandments  
3. to be kept most diligently. **(R)**
4. O! that my ways may be directed to keep thy justifications.  
Then shall I not be confounded,  
when I shall look into all thy commandments. **(R)**
5. I will praise thee with uprightness of heart,  
when I shall have learned the judgments of thy justice.  
I will keep thy justifications:  
O! do not thou utterly forsake me. **(R)**
6. By what doth a young man correct his way?  
By observing thy words.  
With my whole heart have I sought after thee:  
let me not stray from thy commandments. **(R)**

7. Thy words have I hidden in my heart,  
that I may not sin against thee.  
Blessed art thou, O Lord:  
teach me thy justifications. **(R)**
  8. With my lips I have pronounced all the judgements of thy mouth.  
I have been delighted in the way of thy testimonies,  
as in all riches. **(R)**
  9. I will meditate on thy commandments:  
and I will consider thy ways.  
I will think of thy justifications:  
I will not forget thy words. **(R)**
  10. Give bountifully to thy servant, enliven me:  
and I shall keep thy words.  
Open thou my eyes:  
and I will consider the wondrous things of thy law. **(R)**
  11. I am a sojourner on the earth:  
hide not thy commandments from me.  
My soul hath coveted to long for thy justifications, at all times. **(R)**
  12. Thou hast rebuked the proud:  
they are cursed who decline from thy commandments.  
Remove from reproach and contempt:  
because I have sought after thy testimonies. **(R)**
  13. For princes sat, and spoke against me:  
but thy servant was employed in thy justifications.  
For thy testimonies are my meditation:  
and thy justifications my counsel. **(R)**
- Final:      Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.
